1- Project description

BESTMEDGRAPE responds to the Overarching Objective ENI CBC Med programme of fostering sustainable economic, social and territorial development. It takes stock from over 10-year R&D of the partners in the fields of grape valorisation, waste exploitation and development of nanotechnological antioxidant/anti-inflammatory/anti-neurodegenerative formulations, areas where international patents have been obtained. The partnership expects to produce a substantial change in areas where winemaking could not profit from recent technological applications due to generalized economic slowdown and conflicts affecting the Med area.

BESTMEDGRAPE aims at supporting the creation of new start-ups/SMEs by transferring scientific/technological knowledge on local grape cultivars and exploitation of wine by-products as a source of bioactive compounds that are transformed in innovative commercial health products, when appropriately incorporated in ad hoc nanocarriers.

2- Subject of the call

Ferjani Bel Hadj Ammar- Cité El Khadra-Tunis, represented by its president Mr Mohamed Ben Cheikh, as a tunisian partner of the project A_A.21_0035 **BESTMEDGRAPE** “New Business opportunities & Environmental suSTainability using MED GRAPE nanotechnological products” is publishing this public note for the selection of an **External Expert in charge of Cross-border technology platform and Institutional capacity building** conformly to the administrative and technical specifications mentioned in the project description and to the **requirements of the Work Package 3**, to the applicable laws and to the present document.

3- Job description

The Institutional Capacity Building Expert should ensure the implementation of the following tasks of BESTMEDGRAPE project:

1. The creation and management of a Cross Border technology platform for skill exchange and contamination.
2. Development of a sourcing strategy for the selection of 30 potential enterpreneurs, their accompaniement, their business implementation and incubation
3. Information Sessions for the selection of 30 potential enterpreneurs.
4. Networking between the different stakeholders of winemaking and capacity building in Tunisia and in the different countries involved in the project.
5. Setting a capitalization plan.

6. Supporting the Institutional Capacity Building among in Tunisia and in the different countries involved in the project.
7. Redaction of regular monitoring reports for the evaluation of the institutional and individual capacity building of the entrepreneurs.
8. Keeping records of the institutional and individual capacity building and monitoring documentation of the project.
9. Coordination the draft of the capitalization plan.

4- Requirements

- Absolute commitment to high ethics and integrity
- Be familiar with transborder EU programs, with at least one previous experience in a similar project.
- Be familiar with standard office project management programs and with business sharing platforms and web technologies.
- Be familiar with institutional and individual capacity building projects with special interest in the accompaniment and incubation aspects.
- Excellent interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills (English) including active listening skills.
- Demonstrate good organization, problem-solving, and teamwork skills
- Be flexible with a high commitment to achieving deadlines
- Demonstrate adaptability to differences in age, culture, gender, nationality and religion

- A prior experience in a transborder project cofinanced by the EU.
- An experience in project implementation of at least 5 years.

10 - Selection :

The evaluation Commission constituted by the governing body of the CNSPBA-UTICA will be charged of opening and examining the applications.

The choice of the selected application will be communicated **at last the 18th November 2019**.

10 - Cancellation :

The CNSPBA-UTICA retains the right to cancel the contract:

- If the applicant doesn't not fulfilled his obligations. In this case, he warns him by sending him a registered letter so that he fulfills his obligations within a period not exceeding ten days from the date of the sending of the warning and following the expiration this period, the CNSPBA-UTICA may appoint the applicant it deems appropriate.
- In case of fraud in the type and quality of the results of the work or non-compliance with the technical specifications, the remuneration will be refused.

11 - Litigation :

Settlement of disputes related to the implementation of the contract should be managed in consent mutual benefit and in the event that this is not possible, recourse may be had to the to settle these disputes amicably in accordance with Decree 123 of Order 3158 of the year 2002 (of 17 December 2002) relating to the organization of public contracts.

If the resolution of the disputes could not be amicable, there will be recourse to the courts of Tunis.
